Guidance on using Sched

Please note that Sched is merely an online timetable and viewing it does not constitute a conference booking. The "Schedule" will appear in a **Simple** format (bars across the page, colour-coded in accordance with the **Type** list below). At the top left-hand side of the page you can hover over the Schedule box to view the timetable in other formats according to your preference – you may prefer the **Grid** format. Adjacent to the Schedule is the Speakers heading, which if you click on it will enable you to perform a search. Adjacent to that is a Sponsors heading, within which participants can search those that have sponsored elements of the Annual Conference. And finally, there is an Exhibitors heading, within which participants can view where exhibitors are located for the duration of the event within the Pope Building (Rooms A13 and A14), along with a few details of what organisations can offer.

There are a number of filter options to help delegates to decide upon their personal agenda across all 3 days, or upon individual days. The Sched Attendees User Guide can be found [here](#) including personalising your schedule and using Sched on a mobile phone or tablet

Once you have clicked on the link, you will see a number of options on the right-hand side of the main page

- The **Search Box** at the top will enable you to search by session title or presenter's name
- **Filter by date** will enable you to view each or all of the 3 days
- **Filter by venue** merely sorts into the various rooms by their references on Waterside Campus
- **Filter by type** includes a selection of 5 colour-coded broad audience types including

 Post-16  11-19  Primary  All  Technicians  Frontier Sc

If you hover over any of the coloured dots representing **Type**, the themes (below) will appear and are clickable for sorting if required. **The Key Stage / Audience** icon displayed will enable delegates to further select a sub-set including 0-4yrs / 5-7yrs / 7-11 yrs / 11-14 yrs / 14-16yrs / Post-16 / Technicians / Advisors & Consultants / ECTS / FE & Skills / Teacher Developers' / Global Science / Industry / ITEs / Research / Trainees

Within the types are the **Themes**, one of which underpins each session. For 2025, these are Assessment / Curriculum and New Teaching Approaches / Frontier Science / Inclusion & Diversity including SEND / Practical Work / Professional Journeys / Research / Sustainability, Climate Change & Environmental Issues / Using AI to Deliver the Science Curriculum / Wellbeing and Effective Working Practices / Other.

The filters can all help in selecting areas of interest across your day(s) attending conference and creating your personal agenda. Where presenters have provided a Twitter handle, delegates may also follow their session or Twitter feed. It is important to note that clicking on a session within Sched does not provide a reservation for that session and is merely an expression of interest. The ASE does not use the Sched reservation functionality for its' Annual Conference – participants attend sessions on a first-come, first-served basis according to room capacity.
