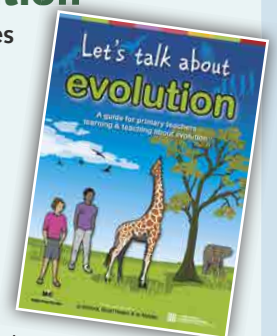


Let's talk about evolution
