Physics for Non-Specialists Saturday Morning CPD

This course comprises a series of modules, and aims to support nonspecialist, early career and trainee teachers with physics teaching to Key Stage 4 (ages 14-16). All modules are delivered by experienced trainers from Physics Partners working in partnership with ASE. Each module is a 3-hour Saturday session, and will focus on one topic. The overarching aim is to improve participants' confidence in teaching physics. The course covers common physics misconceptions, pedagogical content knowledge and a structured approach to tackling GCSE-level examination questions. Novel teaching approaches are introduced, as well as relevant online resources, including the Millgate/ASE's Concept Cartoons. a valuable learning resource used by many teachers in physics lessons, which are available at discounted rates for course delegates.
